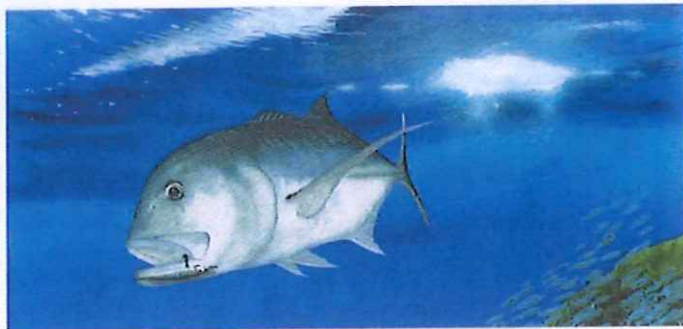


Gamefish artworks for your wall

ANGUS Hulme is a Brisbane-based illustrator, artist and graphic designer with a keen interest in gamefishing and the species we chase. He's been a keen angler and artist since his early childhood, and his artistic work employs a broad range of illustration techniques and mediums, from black and white graphite pencil sketches right through to full-colour gouche or airbrush paintings. Previously, Angus has been commissioned to illustrate fishing publications, fishing industry projects, private commemorative pieces, and even fishing tournament awards.



Angus has now turned his talents to producing marine artworks depicting bluewater species and situations. His first painting is this giant trevally, depicted in a classic sportfishing scenario.

It's been rendered using a combination of acrylic paints and watercolour techniques, combined with some airbrush work. The finished piece measures approximately 80 x 50cm, and a total of 50

top-quality limited edition prints in A2 size (measuring approx 60 x 42cm) have been produced. These are available direct from the artist for \$80 plus postage costs.

Living it up in the wilds of Ningaloo Reef

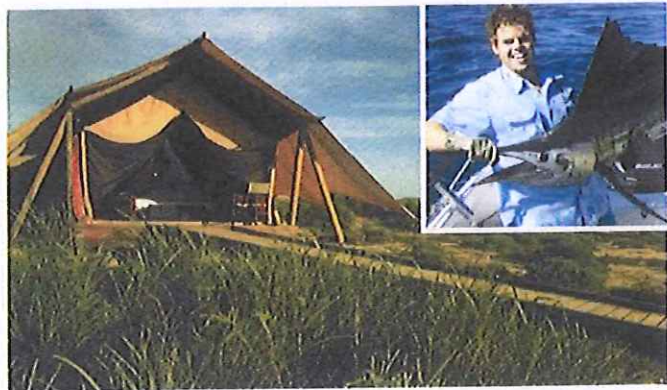

They now have a new LeisureCat 8000 Sportsfisher, so the camp is an ideal base for serious anglers wanting to experience a wilderness adventure, as well as some serious gamefishing. With world-class whale shark diving and lots of other fun activities, it's also a destination with a lot to offer an angler's non-fishing partner.

Ningaloo Reef offers great fishing all year-round, but between October and April, blue marlin and sailfish, as well as wahoo, tuna, giant trevally and Spanish mackerel, are prolific – all just a few nautical miles offshore.

At present, Sal Salis Ningaloo Reef is offering a launch special with an additional free night's accommodation and free day's fishing with the booking of a three-night package. This includes accommodation, all meals and beverages, use of fishing equipment and daily guided fishing excursions. Extreme Blue Water Fishing Portland

EXTREME Blue Water Fishing Portland is the first in a new series of fishing DVDs from current Australian spearfishing champion Rob Torelli of Blue Water Hunting International. It's been put together as an educational, entertaining and exciting production that showcases the exceptional fishing for southern bluefin tuna off Portland, Victoria.

Torelli teams up with Simon Rinaldi from Red Hot Fishing Charters, and the DVD shows

Simon landing a spectacular 101kg southern bluefin. They also encounter some great albacore action and numerous smaller bluefin. Simon demonstrates how to go mako shark fishing – before landing a great mako on 10kg tackle. Torelli takes us underwater as he pursues a big southern bluefin tuna by spearfishing. This unprecedented underwater action shows him catching a new spearfishing world record for southern bluefin and is a highlight of the show.
